Most UnitedHealthcare medical plans cover annual flu shots at 100 percent when you use a contracted network provider, such as those listed in this flier. Ask your employer or check your plan documents for your specific coverage details.



Show your health plan ID card to confirm pharmacy participation.

The flu affects millions of people each year and can lead to serious illness, or even death. The flu is a contagious illness caused by influenza viruses that infect the lungs, throat and nose. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the best way to prevent the flu is by getting vaccinated each year.¹

Where to get your flu shot

There are several ways you can obtain this year's flu vaccine. Be sure to use a contracted network provider such as those listed in this flier.

- 1. Contact your primary care physician to schedule your annual flu shot. A normal office visit copayment or coinsurance may apply.
- 2. Visit one of the select retail locations or pharmacies listed on this flier. Vaccine supplies may vary by location.

Retail locations and pharmacies²
