



## How to find a network doctor, lab, hospital or facility

**Using Network providers may help lower your health care costs and save you money.**

Finding a network doctor who you trust is one way to help you stay healthy and create a health care team to manage your overall health. Reviewing your plan network and identifying the doctor(s) that may be right for you will be an important first step in getting the most from your health care plan.

### For UnitedHealthcare SignatureValue® HMO Plans

With the UnitedHealthcare SignatureValue plans one of the decisions you make in managing your health is choosing your personal Primary Care Provider (PCP) from the plan network. You and your doctor will work as a team, along with nurses, specialists, and other health care providers to help you manage your overall health.

- 4 Select **Find a Doctor** or **Facility** under the Benefits tab
- 5 Under **Medical** select your **State** and **Plan**
- 6 You can then search by **Location, Name or Medical Group**
  - 1 Enter City, State or ZIP code
  - 2 **Select Your Plan from the drop down list**
  - 3 Select Provider Type (Primary Care Provider)
  - 4 Click on **Find Providers Now**
